1. Opening Remarks

2. Approval of the agenda

3. Presentation and approval of the Minutes of AGM – 7th November 2020

Minutes were approved unanimously as proposed by Allam Prem and seconded by Basani Pratap Reddy.

4. Message from the president

President expressed his happiness to the fact that Jana Vikasa revised its aims and objectives accordingly, and planned to take up development programs along with humanitarian aid as they did at the beginning of Jana Vikasa. He acknowledged and appreciated SOPAR's constant support for Jana Vikasa.

He appreciated the dedicated services of staff members of Jana Vikasa even during COVID-19. He further thanked free services of JV executive members and above all, extended his gratitude to the founder Bala Theresa for her endless support to Jana Vikasa.

5. Annual report

Upon the proposal of G. Rama, seconded by Allam Prem, Board approved unanimously to appoint SCV & associates of Chartered Accountancy Firm to audit the accounts of Jana Vikasa for the year 2021-22.

8. Approval of the Annual Budget

Director Pushpa presented the consolidated budget of local and foreign funds for the year 2021-22.

With the above recommendations proposed by Allam Prem and seconded by G. Rama, the budget presented for the year 2021-22 was unanimously approved.

9. FCRA funds utilization: Shoury Reddy explained about the changes made by the Indian government regarding NGOs receiving foreign fund utilization from the year /2020-21 onwards.

10. Elections:

Elections were not required.

11. 80 G Certificate to JVSSS: Jana Vikasa, in order to receive local donations, it has to get 80 G certificate. So that local donors will get tax exemption (tax deduction).

The above recommendation is proposed by Allam Prem and seconded by G.Rama, to apply for 80 G certificate for JVSSS.

12. TDs amount: We have to get TDs amount from the government. So JVSSS founder told to follow and to get it as soon as possible.

13. Closing

The meeting closed at 7.45 pm. President appreciated all the members and guests for adopting the new technology and attending the virtual meeting. He thanked them for their active participation and support. He expressed gratitude to SOPAR Board and Call of the Poor for their generous support. He expressed his gratitude to Bala Theresa Gingras for her endless support.

ACTIVITY REPORT 2021-22

Jana Vikasa, always tries to help more and more deserving needy poor people through Humanitarian projects and developmental projects. Thus Jana Vikasa helped (336) members during the reporting year 2021-22.

1. Humanitarian Program:

1.1. Jana Vikasa helped 88 old people at Ananthapur – A.P. They are provided with nutritious food & clothes.



1.2. Jana Vikasa helped 86 mentally, physically challenged men, children, aged and the disabled with food, clothes & medicines at Fathima Nagar



1.3 Jana Vikasa helped 30 children that are suffering with HIV-AIDS at Fathima Nagar. The children are provided nutritious food, medicines and clothes and are put in nearby schools and helped in their studies.



2. Handicapped children: 100 (14 areas in Telangana)

Some children are born physically handicapped. They are neglected or discriminated by the society without their own fault. To boost such children, Jana vikasa chose 100 handicapped children from 14 places. They are psychologically boosted and motivated for one hour. Children are from Dantalapally, Maripeda, Thorrur, Gangadevipally, Mallakapally, Huzurabad, Siddipet, Hasanparthy, Bejjanki, Jammikunta, Husnabad, Wardhanpet, Ramanthapur & Nagar Kurnool. Each child is helped with a school bag, 2 bed sheets, towel, steel plate, steel glass, water bottle & snacks.



3. Education help to Widow's children

Widows are being looked down and neglected in the society. It's very difficult for a women to take care of the whole family. So Jana vikasa thought of helping 32 widow's children for their education. They are given stationary like school bag, books, pens, pencils, geometry box, one dress, chapples, sandals etc.,



4. Closing

Jana Vikasa is determined to continue helping the needy in all its capacities.

FCRA Inspection: President will explain to the board:

- FCRA Renewal inspection on 10th Jan/2022. President S.I.M.Reddy & Allam Pushpa attended the inspection at Jana Vikasa office.
- They have sent a questionnaire with 12 points to keep ready.
- They asked 3 years projects details, accounts, audit reports & board members details,
- Inspection person spoke with board members, visited House of Joy & divine Mercy.
- Board members of SOPAR – Donor organization
- Asked present year accounts, project applications & reports of this ongoing year etc.
- 80 G: Certificate: We did not apply

Society registration office at state level

All societies are to be registered at state level at Hyderabad. Every year all societies have to submit their annual report after AGM. All files are to be scanned and to be updated on online. Government shifted the office to district level headquarters. So, previous Jana Vikasa files are shifted from Hyderabad to Warangal. Unfortunately, Jana Vikasa files are not found at Warangal from 7 years. So Jana Vikasa is not updated at state level office.
